Born January 21, 1932, Supt. Moses Wright Sr. was raised in the midst of the great depression. The youngest of 15 children, he was born to Rosie Neal and Jacob Wright, Sr. His parents owned a large farm in Grenada County where he helped with the family business. Wright learned his early lessons in business and leadership from his Dad. This is when he developed a liking to raising cattle and horses.

In 1953 while in the local downtown, he met a girl by the name of Charles Evelyn Liddell. He was immediately smitten; they were married the following year. Together they had 11 children, 7 daughters and 4 sons, 30 grandchildren, and 15 great-grandchildren.

A profound experience with Holy Ghost led him into his life's purpose where he accepted his call to serve in the ministry in June 1968. He delivered his first message from St. John 9:4, "I must work the works of Him who sent me while it is day; for when night cometh, no man can work." He began traveling throughout the state and district preaching and teaching the word of God. He ran numerous revivals inspiring other young men and women to give their lives to Christ through his, "Holiness is Right " empowerment messages. Upon his call into the ministry he received unwavering support and assistance from his wife Charles Evelyn; the pair became affectionately known as Mamadear and Papadear.

He learned much under the tutelage of his mentors, Bishop B.S. Lyle and Superintendent A.D. Ford. As they continued to inspire him to dedicate himself to the Lord, he grew in boldness and leadership. After the passing of Grenada District Superintendent, A.D. Ford in 1971, he was appointed by Bishop B.S. Lyle as the 2nd Superintendent of the No.8 Northern Mississippi Jurisdiction. He was appointed to the position at the age of 39 making him the youngest ever superintendent appointed in the Church of God in Christ at that time. Supt. Wright was also the first ever to be assigned to the Office of Superintendent before becoming a Pastor. In addition to working passionately in the ministry during this time, Supt. Wright also served as one of the caretakers for the honorable Bishop B.S. Lyle until his passing.

His first Pastoral Assignment was the House of Prayer COGIC in Kosciusko, MS where he served for 22 years. In 1971 he was appointed as Pastor of Water Valley COGIC in Water Valley, MS. He later named the church House of Prayer as he believed Matthew 21:13 "And my house shall be a House of Prayer"; he served as Pastor of the church for 50 years. In 1995, after the passing of Pastor William Pratt, Sr. Bishop T.T. Scott appointed the Superintendent to serve as pastor for Battle Temple COGIC in Grenada, MS where he served for 27 years.

After the passing of the Late Mother Charles Evelyn Wright in 2003, Superintendent Wright married Sister Rose Merry Seals who assisted him faithfully in life and ministry. Throughout his ministry he has enlightened many in the world, through passionate teachings, preaching, the gift of laying on of hands, speaking in tongues, prophesying and the gift of divine healing. Until the day of his passing, January 11, 2022, Supt. Moses Wright, Sr. continued teaching and preaching the Word of God. He was dedicated to his wife, family, the work of the ministry, leading his congregation, serving and supporting his Bishop, administrative assistants, fellow Superintendents, his Pastors of the district and members.

He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers, sisters, the mother of his 11 children, our dearly departed, the late Mother Charles Evelyn Wright, and his son-in-law, the late Erwin Gillespie. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife, Sister Rose Merry (Seals) Wright, his 11 children, Evelyn GeNether (Elder Freeman) Willingham, Evangelist Tylzen (Pastor Garvin) Williams, Jeffery Wright, Sherley Gillespie, Fitzgerald (Kaye) Wright, Moses Jr (Kathleen) Wright, Bessie Wright, Sherlenda Wright, Sherrell Wright, Charles "Tony" (Leslie) Wright, Felechia LaShun (Andre) Oates, 30 grandchildren, 15 great-grandchildren and a host of nieces, nephews, and cousins.

He leaves to cherish and honor the legacy of his leadership, the House of Prayer-Kosciusko church family, House of Prayer-Water Valley church family, Battle Temple-Grenada church family, the No.8 District and the Leaders.
