

Pastor Eddie Scales, Sr. was born October 26, 1942 to the late George and Sallie Mae Scales in Leflore County, Mississippi. He was the seventh of nine siblings.

Pastor Scale's parents, 3 brothers, Clarence, Jimmie, Tommie and three sisters, Mae, Rosie, and Mary Lee preceded him in death.

Pastor Scales, met and married the love of his life "Lois" affectionately known to him as "Laus" on August 13, 1966. To this union two sons were born.

Pastor Scales accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior as a young man. Later, he became a member of the St. Luke Church of God in Christ under the leadership of the late Superintendent O. S. Sheard. He continued to served faithfully until he was appointed as pastor of the St. Paul Church of God in Christ, Kilmichael, MS from 1982-1998. In 1994 he became the pastor of Greater Pentecostal Church of God in Christ in Greenwood, MS under the leadership of the late Bishop T. T. He received his diploma while serving in the United States Army. He was deployed to Vietnam and was honorably discharged. Upon returning home, He pursued a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Arts at Mississippi Valley State University.

Pastor Scales was employed at National Picture Frame Company, Baldwin Piano Company, a driver for Mississippi Valley State Transit Services. Additionally, he served as a licensed insurance agent for Primerica Insurance Company, and served as a substitute teacher for the Greenwood Public School District.

Pastor Scales enjoyed life to the fullest. He loved working in his garden and sharing the fruits of his labor. On Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 8:10 p.m. He was called from labor to reward in the comfort of his home surrounded by family.


